

### *Teacher's Note*

- Encourage students to make their map look as artistic as they can but remind them it must be workable still.
- Try some of the finished maps. Can you locate some of the special places?

### *Suggested Activities:*

- ❖ You can help students by making their maps look old. Either give them yellow or recycled paper to work with or do the following. Carefully hold a white piece of paper above a match or cigarette lighter. Not too close or it will burn. The paper will slowly turn an old yellow colour. Some of the edges can be slightly burned but not too much. Always supervise this activity or prepare burned, yellow maps beforehand to avoid students seeing how it's done. Warn them about dangers of fire and not to try this themselves. Safety is very important.
- ❖ By using two thin sticks and gluing the end of the map around them, students can roll their map like a scroll.
- ❖ Instead of using paper for the treasure map you could use old cloth material or thin leather.
