

Teacher's Note

Answers:

- The 4 missing letters are: B E A R
- Check student's alphabet before they cut the letters out.
- Check if they can place the letters back in alphabetical order after they have scrambled them up.
- You could have students work in pairs to make words or short sentences.

Suggested Activities:

- ❖ Divide the class in small groups. Each group is to make as many words as possible from the letters they have already cut out from the worksheet. How many correctly spelled words can each group make in 3 minutes?
- ❖ Divide the class in small groups. Each group is to leave a message for the teacher, made from the letters they have already cut out from the worksheet.
- ❖ Write most of the alphabet letters scrambled or in order on a blackboard or white-board. Ask students to find the missing letters. Repeat this game several times.
- ❖ Write all the alphabet letters on 26 cards. Give each student a letter or several letters until all the letters in the alphabet are gone. Say a word out loud. The students having the correct letters should line up in front of the class and quickly form (spell) that word. (Lots of fun)
- ❖ Ask at random what letter comes before or after a certain letter. E.g. What letter comes before R. What letter comes after L.
