

Teacher's Note

- Help students locate some of the computer components mentioned on their worksheet. If possible obtain an old computer and open up the case for students to see what a motherboard, chip or hard-drive looks like. Try a computer shop, they might be willing to release an old non-working case for your use.
- Computer shops or second hand shops sometimes have old computer magazines which they either give away or sell very cheap. Use these for students to find computer related pictures to glue on a large poster.

Suggested Activities:

- ❖ Make a collage out of computer related pictures only.
- ❖ Design a computer from recycled materials as a class project. Use cardboard boxes, old packaging, match boxes etc.
