

Teacher's Note

- Ensure a prism is available for students to observe the colours that emerge from it when held in sunlight.
- Students can be creative and artistic when writing their poem. When they are happy with their final poem draft ask them to decorate the paper the poem is written on. They could cut the writing paper into an unusual shape before writing their poem on it.

Suggested Activities:

- ❖ *Ask students to make a list of all the colours they can see around them.*
- ❖ *Ask students which two colours they can mix to obtain another colour.
E.g. blue + yellow = green red + yellow = orange.*
- ❖ *Display the poems the students have written using lots of colour to decorate the display board or wall.
Use balloons, crepe paper or confetti.*
