

Teacher's Note

Synonyms:

- begin-start, large-big, closed- shut, harm-hurt, loud-noisy, quiet-still, mix-stir.

Antonyms:

- sad-glad, begin-stop, sour-sweet, right-left, give-take, before-after, work-play.

Suggested Activities:

- ❖ Ask students for more examples of synonyms and antonyms. Write them on a black board or white board.
- ❖ Write synonyms on flash cards. Write one word on one side and another word that means the same on the other side. Ask students to help you make flash cards.
- ❖ Write antonyms on flash cards. Write one word on one side and another word that means the opposite on the other side. Ask students to help you make flash cards.
- ❖ Make a wall poster depicting antonyms in picture. Use pictures of people sitting and people standing. Use a picture of a lemon and one of sweets. Use pictures of someone working and someone playing.
