

Teacher's Note

- Check students' spelling and drawing.

Suggested Activities:

- ❖ When everyone is finished writing their story ask some students to read theirs to the class.
- ❖ Choose a storybook to read to your students. Start reading, every now and then stop and omit a word. Ask students to fill in the word you omit. Students need to take turns in this exercise so everyone has the opportunity say at least two words of their choice. The story will take a funny shape because it won't be anything like the one in the book. This can be fun and a creative way of expressing themselves.
