

Teacher's Note

- After reading the story with your students ask them to explain who was tolerant and who wasn't. Discuss why Katie was not tolerant. (She wished she could throw the ball as well as Fred could, and he was left handed.)
- Explain that tolerance is being kind to others and that each person needs kindness and tolerance. Just because we are all different doesn't mean we need to treat each other nasty.
- Ask students if they can think of a situation where they were tolerant.
- Check their story once written. Maybe you could read some out loud if the student doesn't mind.
- Check the student's picture of how they were tolerant.

Suggested Activities:

- ❖ Discuss how students can learn to be tolerant towards each other. A good discussion point if there is any form of bullying going on in.
- ❖ Discuss if students are tolerant at home. Ask them to give you some examples.
- ❖ Give students examples of how you were tolerant at one stage or maybe quit often.
- ❖ Explain to your students that tolerance will make them a nicer person.
