

Teacher's Note

- Ask students to pronounce the Dutch words out loud.
- Check if students found all the Dutch words in the puzzle.
- Typical Dutch things found in the Netherlands are as follows: cheese, apples, deer, wooden shoes, windmills, dykes and canals.
- Capital City of the Netherlands is *Amsterdam*.
- Provide tracing paper for students in order to trace or copy the outline of the Netherlands. Check if they have marked where Amsterdam is located.

Suggested Activities:

- ❖ View a video about the Netherlands. Your library may be able to locate one for you.
- ❖ Listen to Dutch language spoken on a tape. Libraries sometimes have Dutch language tapes that you can borrow.
- ❖ Have the students write an essay about the Netherlands.
- ❖ Use this worksheet in conjunction with the other Dutch worksheets in this book.
- ❖ Make a poster as a class project, with short fact boxes and pictures about the Netherlands. Check at a travel agency for some colourful picture brochures.
