

Teacher's Note

- Students will probably have difficulty reading the German passage but the idea is to view written German.
- Compare the German passage with the English passage with your students. Can they see any words similar or pick out German words and translate them?
- Read the German passage out loud to your students. Can they repeat some of the words in German?
- Help them locate Germany on a map. Find Hamburg and the Elbe River.
- Discuss what a U-Bahn is. Find a picture of one in a book.
- Try to locate the Michel church, Michaeliskirche. A multimedia encyclopedia might be a useful source.

Suggested Activities:

- ❖ Invite a German speaking person to speak to your students.
- ❖ Listen to some traditional German music.
- ❖ Obtain travel brochures that have pictures of Germany. Make a poster with the pictures and write underneath what they are.
- ❖ Locate books about Germany and view these together.
- ❖ Discuss what a U-Bahn is and make a model U-Bahn as a project.
