

Teacher's Note

- Check the ten sea creatures students wrote.
- Over-fishing, pollution and careless supervision of oceans, seas and waterways can lead to the endangerment of sea creatures becoming extinct.
- 24 octopus arms
- 30 sea tubes
- Help students decide what sea creature they are going to make. Ensure enough material is available to make the sea creatures. Hang them in a fishing net from the ceiling if possible. Dangle green strips of crepe paper for seaweed. It will give a pleasant effect for your students to admire.

Suggested Activities:

- ❖ Discuss the importance of ocean life and the necessity to keep the balance in nature. The extinction of one creature or plant species can often lead to the extinction of another. Life supports other living creatures.
- ❖ Visit a marine park or museum where under water creatures are displayed.
