- Organise for each student to have access to the web site

- Download some of the worksheets available on that site for your students.
- Ask students to observe and remember what they read on the web site. Can they tell you afterwards?

Suggested Activities:

- ❖ Computer technology is huge these days and each student should have access to a computer on a regular basis. Try to have each student spend at least 1 hour a week at the computer.
- ❖ Design and make a butterfly and/or otter poster. Search old magazines for pictures. Write educational facts on the poster.
- ❖ Make a really big butterfly from coloured paper. This can be a class project. Hang it from the ceiling when finished.
- ❖ Visit a butterfly farm or a zoo which has a butterfly farm. Teach your students more about the butterfly.
- ❖ Visit a zoo which has otters. Find out with your students what they eat, how long they live, where they are in the wild etc.
