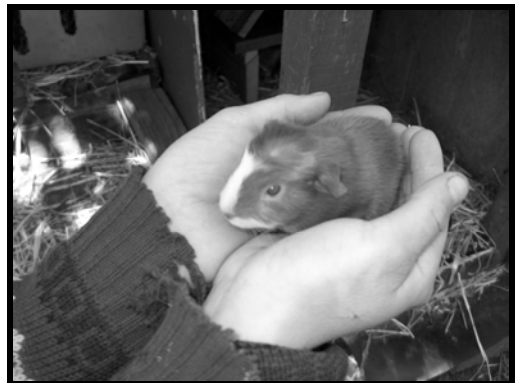


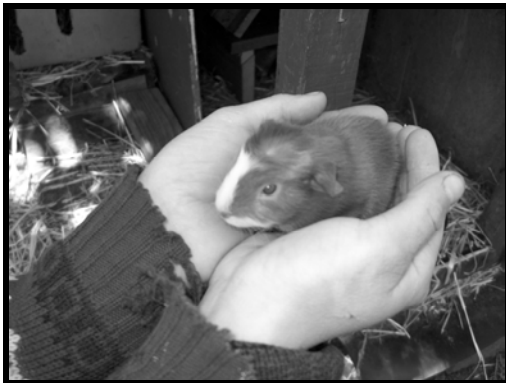
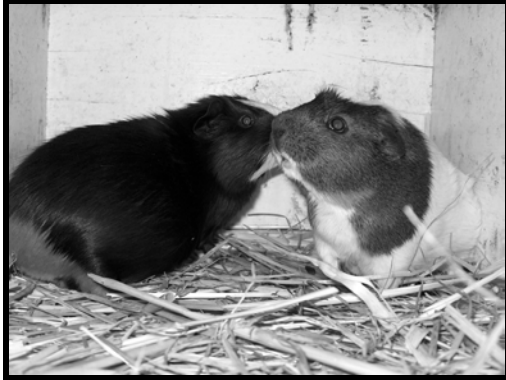
Black and White photos

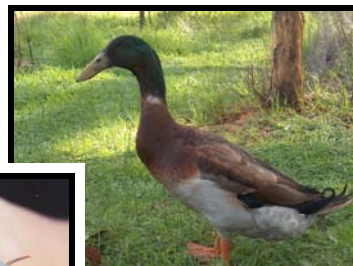
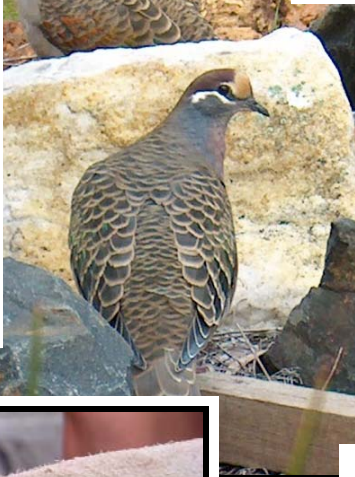
