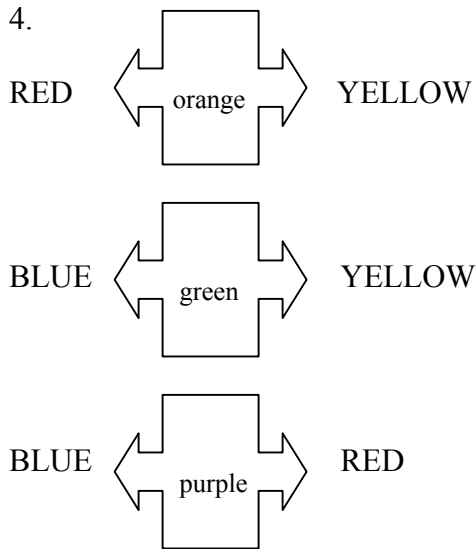


Teacher's Note

Answers:

- There are 3 colours that can't be made by mixing, these are red, blue and yellow. Artists can make all other colours by mixing these 3 primary colours.
- Secondary colour is a colour formed by mixing two primary colours.



- Tertiary colour is a colour formed by mixing two secondary colours.

Suggested Activities:

- ❖ Provide red, blue and yellow paint and have students mix the paints and make as many different colours as they can. Have them write down the colours they made with the colours they mixed in order to achieve their particular colour.
