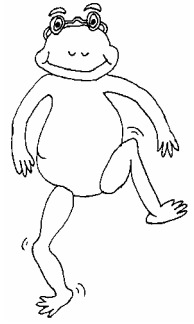

Question mark ?

We use a question mark at the end of a sentence that asks a question.

How are you today?

It is used instead of a full stop, so the next sentence must begin with a capital letter. A question mark is ONLY used when the sentence asks a question that requires an answer. *Which shoes are best to take to the bush?* This sentence is a 'Direct Question' it asks a question that requires an answer.

She asked which shoes are best to take to the bush.

This sentence is an 'Indirect Question' it does not ask a question that requires an answer, so we do not use a question mark.

Question marks put expression into a sentence making it more exciting. If we did not have question marks, full stops, exclamation marks and other punctuation it would make reading difficult and boring.
