Answers:

- Continental shop: sells different food items from European countries.
- Manchester department: is a section of a store where they sell goods such as sheets, pillowcases and bath towels.
- Confectionery shop: sells lollies and many types of sweets.
- Florist: sells flowers.
- Pharmacy: sells drugs, like tablets and different medicines.
- Liquor store: sells alcoholic drinks.
- Haberdashery shop: sells all sorts of small items used in sewing such as buttons, zips and ribbons.
- Hydroponics shop: sells items which are needed to grow plants hydroponically (plants are grown without soil) such as gravel, nutrient salts and special lights.

Suggested Activities:

- ❖ Try to think of more special names used to describe shops and ask students to explain what they sell. Shops like: Hardware, textiles, cobbler, barber, pawnbroker etc.
- ❖ Ask students if they know any other special names describing certain shops which they remember seeing when they went shopping.
