Answers:

Paralyse	Loss of voluntary muscle function.
Abnormality	Different from the usual.
Diagnose	Opinion reached through examination.
Contagious	The passing on of a disease by personal or direct contact.
Hemiplegia	Paralyses of one side of the body.
Paraplegia	Paralyses of the lower half of the body.
Quadriplegia	Paralyses of all four limbs.

Suggested Activities:

- ❖ Contact “The Cerebral Palsy Association” in your state. Obtain information you could share with your students.
- ❖ Obtain the video, *See the Person not the Problem*, from the Cerebral Palsy Association or your local library. Running time 15 minutes.
- ❖ Sometimes people with cerebral palsy talk to schoolchildren to make them aware of the physical disability people with cerebral palsy have. Contact the cerebral palsy association in your state for information.
- ❖ Maybe you have a person with cerebral palsy attending your school, invite the child and their parent or carer to come to your class and meet your students.
