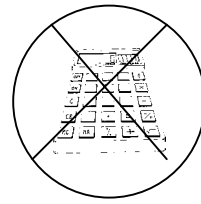

Australia has introduced the GST (Goods and Services Tax). You have probably heard about it and seen the advertising. When you buy something you pay GST on most products. This is usually 10% on top of the product you buy. Let's say if you bought some pencils for \$3 you have to calculate 10% of \$3 which is 0.30 cents. Work out how much GST you would pay on the following items. You may use a calculator. (round up)
