1. Sheep - ram ewe lamb
2. Horse - stallion mare foal
3. Pig - hog sow piglet
4. Elephant - bull cow calf
5. Goat - buck doe kid

Suggested Activities:

- ❖ Use a tape-recorder to record the different animal sounds either made by real animals or by the students themselves. A trip to the zoo or farm can be used to record different animal sounds.
- ❖ Have the students write down more animals and research what they are called as male, female and young.
- ❖ Look at different animal books. Note the difference between males, females and their young. Have students write down details of each animal and describe what they look like. E.g. Lion has a mane, lioness has no mane etc.
