- Check student's drawing and explanation of their favourite animal.

Suggested Activities:

- ❖ Use a tape-recorder to record the different animal sounds either made by real animals or by the students themselves. A trip to the zoo or farm can be used to record different animal sounds.
- ❖ The students could write down more animals and list them in their gender names.
- ❖ Look at different animal books to see the difference between males, females and their young. The students could write down details of each animal and describe what they look like. E.g. Lion has a mane, lioness has no mane etc.
- ❖ Students could investigate what each animals eats, where it lives etc.
