Deepest fresh water lake, 1620metres deep and it's the largest freshwater lake in the world.
4. Sahara desert, North Africa.
Biggest desert, stretches approximately 9.000.000 square kilometres.
5. Angel Falls, Venezuela.
Highest waterfall, greatest uninterrupted drop is 800 metres.
6. Mauna Loa, Hawaii.
Largest active volcano.
7. The Nile, Africa.
Longest river, 6650 kilometres long.
8. Mariana Trench, Pacific Ocean.
Deepest trench situated in the deepest ocean. Mariana Trench is 11 kilometres deep and 2250 km long.
