

A Full Stop

- Certain signs, called points, are used in sentences to mark off their different parts, and to show the relation of each part to the whole.
- Putting in the right points is called punctuation.
- Full stops are used to mark the end of a sentence.
- If a sentence ends in a question mark ? you don't need a full stop.
- If a sentence ends in an exclamation mark ! you don't need a full stop.
- When you have used a full stop to end a sentence, you must start the new sentence with a capital letter.
